Dr. Dethoff called the meeting to order at 4:04 pm.

A quorum was present.

**Approval of Minutes**

**Motion was made by Ms. Schorn, seconded by Dr. Wong, to approve the April 1, 2014 minutes as written. Motion carried unanimously.**

**Health Officer Report**

Mr. Orrs distributed the monthly report. There were no questions.

**Animal Control Legislation**

Dr. Dethoff questioned the next steps of moving this forward. Ms. Katzenmoyer explained that if approved by the Board today, the ordinance would be discussed at the Council Standards of Living Committee on May 19. She stated that if there are no revisions and the Committee agrees to the changes, it can be placed on the Council agenda on May 27 for formal introduction.

Dr. Wong questioned in new section 213 if dwelling referred to a unit or a property. Ms. Katzenmoyer and Ms. Rudy stated that based on past Board discussions it should be per unit. Mr. Coleman will clarify this in the amendment.

The Board did a page by page review of the amendment.

Ms. Rudy suggested several changes including:

- Referring to the State definition of cruelty in the definition section
- Adding "pursuing" to number two of the definition of Dog, Aggressive as this is allowed by State law
- Further defining wild felines in the Exotic Animal definition to differentiate between large game felines (lions, tigers, etc) and feral cats
- Changing "City" to "Animal Control Agency" in letter C of section 216

**Motion was made by Mr. Hospidor, seconded by Ms. Schorn, to amend the document as listed above and move the amendment to the Council Standards of Living Committee agenda on May 19. Motion carried unanimously.**

Ms. Katzenmoyer invited members to attend the Committee meeting to answer questions. Ms. Rudy stated that she will attend. Mr. Coleman and Ms. Katzenmoyer will also be in attendance.
